



BFAC 2026 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Bowling for A Cause is a non-USBC sanctioned Tournament, however we will follow standard USBC rules to govern the event.
2. TOURNAMENT HANDICAP IS 90% OF 230. Entering Average as reported by association records and / or bowl.com, provided they have bowled a minimum of 21 games. The Tournament Director reserves the right to adjust a bowler's average (re-rate) during calendar year.
3. The following rules shall be used to determine the entering average:
 - The 2025/2026 USBC Highest 21 game average listed on bowl.com If none,
 - 2024/2025 USBC Highest 21 game average listed on bowl.com If none,
 - Highest 2025 summer average (21 games minimum)
 - Bowlers without a verifiable average will enter with 230 avg.
 - *The Sport or Challenge Conversion Chart shall apply to adjust Bowlers with a Sport or Challenge verifiable average only to Standard average.*
 - Tournament average must be adjusted at the time of bowling if: The current league average of 21 or more games exceeds the entering average by 10 or more pins.
4. Mixed Teams roster consist of Mixed Teams roster consist of any combination of Men & Women. Mix Doubles roster consists of 1 Women and 1 Men.
 - Multiple participation is allowed in BOTH EVENTS. Teams may not have more than 2 original bowlers on any additional team entry. Doubles may not have more than 1 original bowler on any additional team.
 - No more than 1 current PBA or PWBA member allowed per team and double event.
5. Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice.
6. One lane courtesy will be used.
7. Entries close at midnight on JUNE 30TH 2026. Entry fee will be as follows:
 - \$60 per bowler for Team Event (\$240/Team Entry)
 - \$60 per bowler for Doubles Event (\$120/Doubles Entry)
 - \$40 per bowler Virtual Singles will be available at each Doubles Squad and Doubles Scores will be used. Entry & Payment on Day of Event, CASH ONLY
 - Payment is due prior to tournament.

- Within a week an email will be sent following entry submission to Team Captain confirming:
 - Squad times.
 - Amount due.
 - Payment Instructions
- Full names of all entrants and valid USBC must be shown on the entry form. TEAM CAPTAIN is responsible for submitting correct information.
- *Final deadline for entry is **JUNE 30TH**. You must pre-register and be paid in full by **JUNE 30TH**. we are looking to fill the house with 63 teams & 96 doubles. if both doubles shifts are sold out, we will be opening a third shift Sunday @ 2 PM limited to 30 doubles.*

8. Cash Prize Ratio will be as follows:

- TEAM 1:6 Entrants
- DOUBLES: 1:5 Entrants
- VIRTUAL SINGLES: 1:6 Entrants

9. No changes will be made in the entrant's schedule except in case of emergency and any changes must be approved by the Tournament Director.

10. The Tournament Director will make all the final decisions pertaining to rules and/or entrance eligibility and his/her word is final.

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO RE-RATE ANY ENTRANT BEFORE BOWLING. IF THE ENTRANT REFUSES THE RE-RATE, ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED.
